

Memorandum of Understanding between
Australia and New Zealand Industrial and Applied Mathematics (ANZIAM) and
The Japan Society for Industrial and Applied Mathematics (JSIAM)

As organizations with common goals of supporting the creation and dissemination of knowledge in industrial and applied mathematics, Australia and New Zealand Industrial and Applied Mathematics (ANZIAM) and The Japan Society for Industrial and Applied Mathematics (JSIAM) agree to the following guidelines for mutually beneficial interaction.

1. (Speaker Invitation) Both societies invite an ANZIAM-JSIAM speaker at the annual meeting of ANZIAM and JSIAM to strengthen the relationship between ANZIAM and JSIAM.
2. (Implementation) ANZIAM annual meeting will have a plenary speaker nominated by JSIAM every four years starting from 2025. JSIAM annual meeting will have a keynote speaker of the International Organized Session nominated by ANZIAM every four years starting from 2027.
3. (Nomination) The Invited Speakers Committee (ISC) for the host's annual meeting will approach the other society to submit a short nomination list of speakers with CVs at least 6 months before the annual meeting for consideration. The final decision will be made by ISC, taking into account gender balance and discipline diversity.
4. (Eligibility of Nominees) Both societies will support early to mid-career researchers and enhance collaborations between industry and mathematics. Nominees from academia are to be within 20 years full-time from the award of their PhD, or an equivalent longer duration that accounts for career interruptions. This condition does not apply to nominees of industrial researchers.
5. (Financial Support) Travel and accommodation for the invited speaker at the JSIAM or ANZIAM annual meeting will be organized by the annual meeting committee.
6. (Intellectual Property Rights) The two societies agree that, in the event of research collaboration leading to patent rights, copyrights, and other intellectual property rights, a further agreement must be negotiated in each case subject to the policies of the two societies on intellectual property.
7. (Terms of the agreement) This agreement expires five years from the date of execution but can be renewed at any time by mutual written agreement, with 30 days' notice.
8. (Amendments) Any amendment to or modification of this agreement requires the written approval of both societies.
